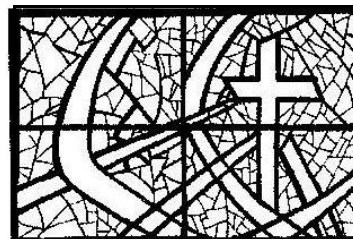

The annual Carnival Service is at 11 am in the warmth & dryness of the Horwich Leisure Centre Sports Hall, which will once again also be the Carnival Arena. After the 45 minute service, when the Mayor and other civic dignitaries and representatives will join us – and at which Paul will share a message of Christian hope – we will join the Carnival Procession at noon, and then staff a number of stalls in the hall publicising church groups, activities and community involvement. There are only two more opportunities to meet to plan this event, and it is vital that all the churches are represented, so please would you make another effort to get along to these two meetings on: **Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> June at 7.30 pm in St. John's Methodist Church** on Victoria Road and **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June** – same time, same place!

The theme this year is '*The Whole World in His Hands*' and we want a good turnout to show the strength of the Christian Church, working together in Horwich and Rivington. Last year, we had just over 200 folk with us, but that is a tiny fraction of the numbers attending our churches each Sunday, so please publicise this and try to make sure that your congregations know that they are needed to witness to God's love for our town. You may have seen in the Bolton News that there is a rival group hoping to bring hundreds of people dressed as 'zombies' to march in the procession – what a shame it would be if those dressed as the '*living dead*' outnumbered those who are alive in Christ, on that day!!!
