REDEEMING OUR COMMUNITIES

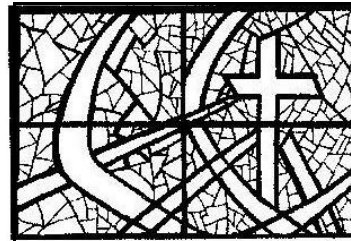
