SPONSORED BIKE RIDE - LONDON to CAMBRIDGE

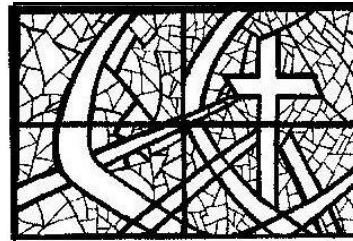
