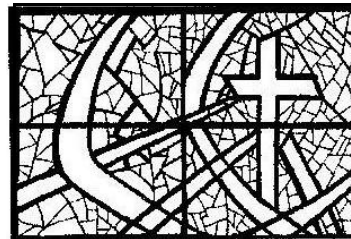
## **MAKE A JOYFUL NOISE - A MUSIC DAY FOR ALL**
