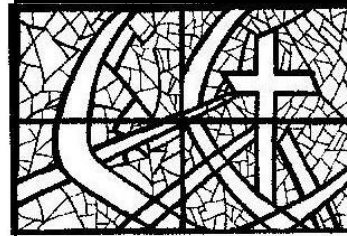
Anthony & Pat at Scripture Union Camp (24th-31st July) helping to minister to 40 boys aged 10-12 years old!
