#### EMPTY SHOEBOXES

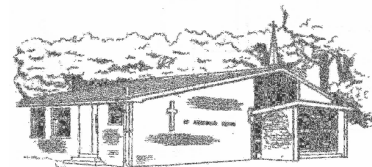
There are one or two spare shoeboxes at the back of Church if anyone needs one or they would like to cover it for use at the warehouse next month.
